NECKBAND, BUTTONHOLE, ARMHOLE BAND.

Buttonhole Band

*Ewrap or latchtool number of stitches needed for band.

With wrong side facing of garment facing you, place onto the needles.

MT – 2 knit 4 rows. CAR

Put machine into hold. MT

Put all needles to hold except first 3 nearest to carriage. MT Knit 8 rows. CAR

** Push next 3 needles to WP knit 1 row COL.

Push first 3 needles to hold knit 7 rows.**

Repeat from ** to ** to last 3 needles. Knit 8 rows COL.*

Pick up the loop in between each section and place on a needle.

Knit 4 rows and cast off.

I usually knit a plain button band as this is better for sewing on the buttons.

Neck or armhole band

Follow the instructions from * to * You can now leave the loops as decorative or pick up loops as in buttonhole, then knit 2 or 4 rows and cast off.

To make a wider band reverse the process back to the right.

Knit 2 or 4 rows MT over all needles. Cast off

***Alter the number of rows and stitches in hold to suit size and look of garment.
